<u>Mythology</u> – Ancient stories involving gods or goddesses

<u>Metamorphosis</u> – a change in shape or form

Mortal - Human being

<u>Immortal</u> – Lasting forever

Nymph- Minor nature goddess in the form of a beautiful young woman. Dryads are nymphs that lived in the woods.

<u>Hero</u> – a person admired for great deeds or fine qualities

Heroine – a woman who is admired for great deeds or fine qualities

<u>Phenomenon</u> – a rare or important fact or event

<u>Deity</u> – god or goddess

Sacred – holy or religious

<u>Lyre</u> – a string instrument like a harp used by ancient Greeks

<u>Hubris</u> – excessive pride, considered the worst offense

<u>Prophecy</u> – a prediction or a foretelling of events

<u>Tragedy</u> – a story or a play that has an unhappy ending

<u>Comedy</u> – a story or play that has a happy ending.
